THR Calendar Events

May 15th - Heifer Pregnancy EPD/Spring Exposure Inventory 2007. The inventory was mailed out to all members around the 15th of May and should be returned to the National Office postmarked no later than August 18th. The heifer exposure inventory report is available on the web site under REDS - www.redangus.org.

May 29th - Spring Inactivation, Females missing a 2006 record. Females listed as Spring calving cows will be subject to inactivation May 29th, if one of the THR requirements has not been received for 2006. The National Office will be mailing out a list to each member who has females that have been inactivated. If information (calf record or reason code) is submitted to the National Office prior to 7-03-07, the females will be

reinstated without charge. If information is received after that time, the female will be subject to the reactivation fees. A list of inactivated females is available on the web site. Calving records or reason codes may be submitted via RRTS found under REDS. Keep in mind the females have been inactivated and therefore will appear on a separate listing.

June 1st - Fall 2007 Herd Inventories. Inventories will be mailed out by June 5th. The preliminary inventory is based on the previous year's inventory plus disposal and transfer information reported to the National Office by this date.

Fall Herd Inventories are available on-line, via the Red Angus web site under REDS. For details regarding the Fall Inventory Calendar, please see page 19. The calendar will provide you with mail out dates and

return dates of all reports as well as a brief description of the information required to complete the report.

Reminders

All corrections, whether the work is pending or has been processed must be received in writing (mail, fax, or e-mail). Office policy does not allow us to take information over the phone.

Transfer VS. Disposal Code 15 - sold without transfer. If you have sold an animal, please submit the information for transfer. The transfer process will remove the animal from your inventory. **DO NOT** submit a disposal code 15 for animals that you intend to submit for transfer, by doing this you could possibly be subject to reactivation fees when the transfer application is received. **Please print and review** information before sending to avoid recalculation fees and contemporary group errors

Genetic Defects Reporting

Beginning 7-01-07 with the Spring 2007 weaning worksheets which will be mailed out the first week in August, and data submitted on-line via REDS or Cow Sense/Red Wing, members will be asked to checkmark a statement as follows:
