2007 GridMasters

Red Angus' GridMaster award recognizes sets of cattle that excel on the rail and provide real financial rewards back to the producer.

Carcass performance at this level requires the combination of superior Red Angus genetics at the ranch of origin with skilled management and timely marketing at the feed yard. This year, RAAA is proud to recognize eight sets of cattle as GridMasters.

One of this year's recipients is the first Gridmaster to earn the award for cattle marketed through the **Meyer Natural Angus** program.

To account for the different finishing characteristics of "Natural" vs. conventionally fed cattle it was necessary to make slight variations in the awards' specs for cattle marketed through **Meyer Natural Angus**.

These specs include:

- **Minimum of 30 head lot size**
- **Minimum 85% Choice or higher**
- **Maximum 15% YG 4's**
- **Minimum Grid Score of 100**

The specs for cattle marketed through the **Angus America** Grid at participating Cargill plants remained unchanged:

- **Minimum of 30 head lot size**
- **Minimum 80% Choice or higher**
- **Maximum 7.5% YG 4's**

• **Minimum Grid Score of 100**

The **Grid Score** is calculated using the overall performance of the lot and accounts for the percentage premium products obtained and the percentage of Yield Grade 1's and 2's stamped, as well as the overall Choice and Yield Grade 4 percentages.
