

2011 RED ANGUS JUNIOR NATIONAL SHOW INFORMATION

Information regarding the 2011 Red Angus Junior National Show is provided here for you.

Below is a schedule of events for your reference:

Red Angus In Place - Thursday, January 6 - noon mountain time

Exhibitor Meeting - Thursday, January 6 - 9 a.m.

Processing and Check-in of Cattle - Thursday, January 6:

Pen Show cattle: in the Yards - 10 a.m. - 2 p.m.

National Junior and Open Show cattle - on the Hill - 2 p.m. - 6 p.m.

Showmanship entries: by 6 p.m. (sign up and provide age)

The Junior National Show will begin at 8:00 a.m. Mountain time, Monday, January 10, and show order is as follows:

Junior National Red Angus Show - regular heifer classes (see premium book)

Bred and Owned Classes:

Bred and Owned Heifer - registration certificate must show the junior exhibitor as sole breeder. All heifers eligible for the Bred and Owned division will show in one class and one champion Bred and Owned female selected.

Bred and Owned Bull Calf - registration certificate must show the junior exhibitor as sole breeder. All bull calves eligible for the Bred and Owned division will show in one class and one champion Bred and Owned Bull Calf will be selected. Bull calf must show in a Junior National cow/calf pair class to be eligible for the Bred and Owned Bull Calf class

Senior Showmanship - junior exhibitors 16 years through 21 years of age on the day of the show.

Junior Showmanship - junior exhibitors 15 years of age and younger on the day of the show.

Red Angus National Open Show - immediately following Junior Show

Release of Cattle - immediately following the Open Show. All Red Angus must be out of barns by 9:00 p.m., Monday, January 10.

Please be advised of the following Rules and Regulations that will be enforced at the National Red Angus Shows.

- All animals must be properly tattooed and will be inspected at the show. Tattoos must be legible and must match the animal ID and Herd Prefix on the registration certificate. If the animal's tattoo(s) are not legible and cannot be read during processing, it will be allowed to participate in the show but DNA will be required at the owner's expense. If the animal's tattoo(s) are legible but are incorrect, the animal will not be allowed to show. All animals must be properly tattooed and will be inspected by RAAA staff during show check-in on Thursday, January 7. Any animal that comes into the check-in chute and is found to have an incorrect tattoo will automatically be disqualified and not permitted to show. Please - check your tattoos for accuracy BEFORE bringing your animal to the chute!
- JRA members may show an animal that is owned solely by his/her family's ranch; or junior members may show an animal that is owned jointly with other owners but the junior member's name must be on the registration certificate at least 30 days prior to the show. Ownership requirements are subject to the rules and regulations of the Red Angus Association of America.

Only junior members who have cattle entered in the National Red Angus Junior Show will be eligible to compete in showmanship. One champion and one reserve senior showman and one champion and one reserve junior showman will be selected. **SHOWMANSHIP ENTRIES MUST BE MADE DURING RED ANGUS CHECK-IN/PROCESSING ON THURSDAY, JANUARY 7.** There is no entry fee for showmanship but you must sign-up by 6:00 p.m. in order to participate in showmanship.

The Junior Herdsman Award will be presented during the National Open Show on January 10. An anonymous panel of judges will observe all junior exhibitors beginning at check-in and running through the Junior National Show. Areas included in the selection of the Junior Herdsman include sportsmanship, Red Angus knowledge, neatness of stall area...

An Exhibitor meeting (open and junior National shows) will be held on Thursday, January 6 at 9:00 a.m. - the location to be announced. At this meeting, Clint Berry, Commercial Marketing Director, will detail the cattle check-in process, answer questions and outline the show procedures.

ALL JUNIOR EXHIBITORS ARE INVITED! The JRA Board invites you to join them on Sunday, January 9, at 3 p.m., in the sale facility (near the sale ring) for refreshments, junior activities and distribution of the Junior National exhibitor gift. There will be a short meeting and answers to any questions you may have regarding the show on Monday or the JRA.
