PURPOSE:

- Report change in inventory seasons for females (check Fall box if moving from Spring to Fall).
- Report animals no longer active in herd.
- The Herd Inventory returned to the National Office should indicate the list of animals, which will calve between 1/01/12 and 6/30/12.
- 45-day window for females scheduled to calve between 11/15/11 and 6/30/12, or 1/01/12 and 8/15/12.
- Females reported as active on this inventory will be subject to annual assessment in July unless transferred (Bulls not subject to assessment).

Required Fields for Registering/Recording:

Sex	Twin Code	Mating Code
Color Code	HPS Code	Reg. Code
Print - Yes or No	Weaning Date	Weaning Weight

- Include calves with disposal codes, which died before weaning.
 - 2 = Stillborn / full term
 - 3 = Died at birth due to a birth defect
 - 4 = Died at birth for other reasons
 - 5 = Born alive, but died before weaning due to disease
 - 6 = Born alive, but died before weaning due to other reasons
- Include reason codes for females that do not have a calf record.
 - 1 = Open, missed calving opportunity
 - 2 = ET program / donor dam
 - 3 = Moved to next calving season (Example - Spring to Fall)
 - 4 = ET program / recipient cow
 - 5 = Aborted / premature - use this reason code for cow rather than disposal of calf.
- Sire Summary Deadline - in order to guarantee inclusion in the 2013 Sire Summary (available online).
