

Internship Position
Deadline for Applications is December 17, 2018

The Red Angus Association of America (RAAA) is seeking a summer intern for 2019. Approximate starting date is May 20, 2019 and ending date is negotiable depending upon applicant (approximately early to mid-August). This is a full time, paid position. The home base office for RAAA will be in Commerce City, CO. However, working from home may be negotiable, depending on the applicant and proximity to the RAAA office. Applicants must have at least one year of college or university education.

Please read the position description, requirements, and responsibilities carefully and thoroughly.

Responsibilities of this internship include:

- Conduct Feeder Cattle Certification Program (FCCP) and Allied Access (AA) audits at commercial ranching operations. You must have your own reliable vehicle.
- Set up your own travel schedule and contact producers to arrange the audits. Travel expenses are reimbursed. Extensive travel is required.
- Attend an orientation session at the RAAA office plus other training with RAAA staff as deemed necessary.
- Must be a self-starter and have the ability to keep a schedule. Follow-up is essential and the job requires the applicant to be detail-oriented.
- Report to other staff members on activities and work progress.
- Participate in weekly conference calls and other meetings as required.
- May be required to attend at least one Superior Livestock Auction (week long) video sales and manage the booth.
- Visit feedlots and commercial ranches as needed or warranted.
- Travel with other staff as part of the training process.
- May be asked to write some short stories, take photographs, or conduct interviews; however, this is a minor part of the requirements. This is not a communications internship.
- Other duties as required.

Applicants should possess:

- A good working knowledge of the beef cattle industry. Understanding of both purebred and commercial beef production is helpful.
- Attitude of a team player.
- Strong communication skills.
- A valid driver's license and reliable transportation.
- A strong work ethic.
- Ability to stay on track with duties assigned.
- Detail oriented.
- Personal appearance and maturity to reflect a positive, professional image of the RAAA.
- A personality that reflects excellent manners, speech, and oral communication skills.
