

Red Angus Association of America Commercial Marketing Department Summer Internship Program

Purpose

The Red Angus Association of America summer internship program will provide experiential learning related to the beef industry, value-added programs and the functions of the RAAA. The internship will focus on conducting audits for the department's highly successful Feeder Calf Certification Program. The internship provides extensive networking opportunities with commercial producers, beef industry stakeholders and Red Angus staff. The selected candidate will have the opportunity to attend a summer video sale, educational events and training sessions sponsored by the RAAA. Through this experience, the selected candidate will gain a thorough exposure to various beef production practices within the industry.

Eligibility

- Applicants should be a college junior, senior or master's candidate in an agricultural field of study.
- Must have a valid driver's license and reliable transportation.
- Must be a detail-oriented, self-starter who has the ability maintain his/her own travel schedule and paperwork requirements.
- Knowledge or willingness to learn about process-verified programs and their place within the beef industry.

Details

The internship will be a full-time, paid position from late May to mid-August 2021. Work related travel expenses must be documented by the intern and will be reimbursed. There may be some flexibility provided in the start/end dates depending upon the availability of selected candidate.

The position is based out of the RAAA headquarters in Commerce City, Colorado. However, remote work may be negotiable, depending on the applicant and proximity to the RAAA office.

All qualified individuals are encouraged to apply, regardless of location.

Extensive travel is required.
